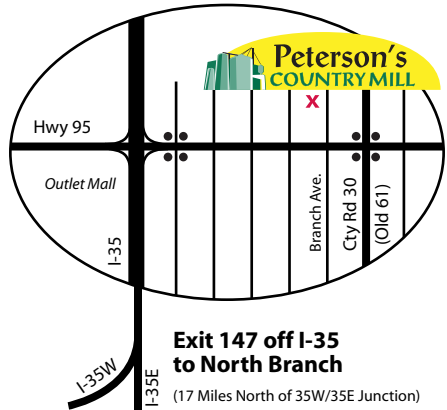

## BARBECUED KABOBS

### Sweet Soy Marinade

Soy Sauce	1/3 cup	Whole Mushrooms	8
Sugar	2 tbsp	Red Medium Onion	1
Cooking Oil	2 tbsp	cut into 8 wedges	
Worcestershire Sauce	1 tbsp	Green Medium Pepper	1
Garlic Clove, minced	1	seeds & ribs removed, cut into 1 inch pieces	
Red Wine Vinegar	1 1/2 tbsp	Red Medium Pepper	1
Pepper	1/8 tsp	seeds & ribs removed, cut into 1 inch pieces	
Beef Top Sirloin Steak,		Cherry Tomatoes	8
cut into 1 inch cubes	1 1/4 lbs.	Small Zucchini	1
		peeled & halved, cut into 16 pieces	

Combine first 7 ingredients in a large bowl. Makes about 1/2 cup of marinade.

Add beef. Stir until coated. Cover with plastic wrap. Marinate in refrigerator for 30 minutes, stirring occasionally. Drain, reserving marinade in a small saucepan. Bring reserved marinade to a boil on medium. Reduce heat to medium-low. Simmer uncovered for at least 5 minutes.

Soak 8 - 8 inch long, bamboo skewers in water for 10 minutes.

Thread beef & vegetables alternately onto skewers. Preheat Barbecue to medium-high. Cook kabobs on greased grill for about 20 minutes, turning occasionally & brushing with reserved marinade, until desired doneness. Makes 8 kabobs.
